**2.1 M/s. Power Turbine Unit:**

As per decision of 43<sup>rd</sup> SLC meeting held on 09-05-2017, clarification was again sought from ASEB as to whether the unit has entered into any Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) with APDCL for selling the power generated in excess of its own consumption for sister concern. Accordingly, the Chief General Manager (Commercial) APDCL vide letter No. CGM(COM) /APDCL/CORRES /2013/75, dated 22-12-2017 informed that the unit can be treated as a standalone and no PPA is available with APDCL till date. The Committee unanimously **Rejected** the claim proposal as the industrial unit is standalone.
