Shri Ravi Capoor, IAS, Additional Chief Secretary to the Govt. of Assam, Industries & Commerce Department & Chairman, State Level committee presided over the meeting and welcomed all the members & officials present in the meeting and asked to place the agenda before the committee for discussion & scrutiny.

Mrs. Manjula Saikia Bhuyan, Additional Director (FP) & Member Secretary of the SLC explained the purpose of the meeting and requested members to deliberate on the Agenda placed before the committee.

Agenda- A.1 Confirmation of the 47th SLC meeting held on 21-12-17:

The minutes of the 47th State Level Committee meeting held on 21-12-17 were circulated among the members. As there was no observation or comments from any members, the Committee confirmed the minutes.

Agenda- A.2 Discussion & approval of claims of 30% CCIS (Below ₹.50 Cr.) Deferred by the earlier SLC-

A total of **08 (Eight) Nos. of deferred** claims placed before the SLC for its decision.

Agenda- A.3 Discussion & approval of fresh claims of 30% CCIS (Below ₹.50 Cr.)-

A total of **46 (Forty Six) Nos. of Fresh Claims** placed before the SLC for its decision.

It was apprised to the committee by the Member Secretary that:

All the claims were scrutinized as per the policy guidelines issued by the DIPP, Government of India from time to time & further informed about the procedure adopted for scrutinizing the claims before placing in the committee. All the claims placed before the committee had already been scrutinized at various levels. Physical verification was initiated by the Office of the GM, DICC, Senior Finance & Accounts Officer & Audit Cell of the Office of the Commissioner of Industries & Commerce, Assam also verified the claims and admissibility of the documents submitted by the claimants in the light of guidelines issued by the Government of India till date. The Committee was also informed that the claims were put up through agenda note by the Office of the Commissioner of Industries & Commerce, Assam were found eligible, admissible and in accordance with the revised guidelines.

In respect of the Expansion claims it was informed that as the basic objective of the Expansion was to enhance the production, productivity, employment and bringing efficiency and reduce the cost of production etc. these aspects should be reflected in the production figure filed by the unit to Excise, Tea Board, Employment, Sales Tax, Income Tax etc. Accordingly as per the decision of the previous SLC, these additional informations were sought from the Expansion units and placed along with the claims.

It was further informed that all the Financial Banks/ Institutions were also invited to the SLC to appraise the status of their financing units.

After threadbare discussion and obtaining views of the Officials of the Banks/ Financial Institutions of the claims financed by them, the Committee Examined all the **54 (Fifty Four)** Nos. of the CCIS claims placed before the SLC and approved **38 (Thirty Eight)** Nos. of claims, **5 (Five)** No. of claims were deferred & **11 (Eleven)** No. of claim were rejected. The decision of the SLC claim wise is placed at Annexure-A, B.
