Sri Ravi Capoor, IAS, Additional Chief Secretary to the Govt. of Assam, Industries & Commerce Department & Chairman of the State Level Committee welcomed all members and officials present in the meeting and requested the Member Secretary to place the Agenda items before the Committee for discussion and scrutiny.

AGENDA NO.1

i. Confirmation of the Minutes of 46TH SLC:

Dr. K.K. Dwivedi, IAS, Member Secretary and the Commissioner of Industries & Commerce informed that the Minutes of the 46th SLC meeting held on 09-05-2018 were circulated to all the members for confirmation. Since there were no comments received from the members, minutes is unanimously accepted by the Committee.

ii. Follow up action on the last Minutes – (Court case matter).

a. M/s. Bhabani Print & Publications, Panikhaiti, Guwahati, Dist. Kamrup (M)

The claim of M/S Bhabani Printers was placed in the 46th SLC and the committee directed the Member Secretary to re-verify the claim in the light of Hon'ble High Court Order by Senior Officer and asked to place the findings before the next SLC for its decision.

Accordingly Sri V.K. Das, Addl. Director (US) examined the relevant documents and placed the report before the SLC. The Committee examined the report as well as the Court Order and after discussion the Committee decided to re-examine the admissibility of the unit by a high level team in the light of observation of Hon'ble High Court Order. After detailed discussion the Committee decided to request to the Department of Industrial Policy & Promotion (DIPP), Govt. of India to send a Field Visit Team to inspect the unit and submit the report urgently and asked the Member Secretary to take up the matter with Department of Industrial Policy & Promotion (DIPP) immediately.

b. M/s. P D P Steels Ltd, Bonda, Narengi, Guwahati-26, Dist. Kamrup(M)

The claim of M/s. P D P Steels Ltd, Bonda, Narengi, Guwahati-26, Dist. Kamrup(M) was placed in the 43rd SLC held on 09-05-2017, the SLC had decided to get a report from IIT, Guwahati alongwith details of production, VAT, Excise return etc.

Report of IIT Guwahati and 3 (three) years production return prior and after modernization of the unit from Excise and VAT was obtained and placed before the SLC. As per report of IIT, Guwahati , the average production of the unit has increased 19.03 , but it is not clear if cost of production has decreased and profit margin has enhanced .

After threadbare discussion the Committee directed the Member Secretary to obtain the additional information i.e. Power consumption, IT return fact if cost of production has come down and profit margin has increased after modernization and to place in the SLC for decision.
