Agenda 1: Confirmation of the Minutes of the last SLC The Minutes of the 55th State Level Committee meeting held on 30.01.2019 was circulated among the members. As there was no observation or comments from any members, the Committee confirmed the Minutes.

Agenda 2: Discussion & approval of claims of 30% CCIS (Below ₹1.5 Crore)

The Member Secretary placed before the Committee a total of **7 nos.** of deferred, & fresh cases.

The Member Secretary informed the committee that:

All the claims were scrutinized as per policy guidelines issued by DIPP, Government of India from time to time. He further informed about the procedures adopted for scrutinizing the claims before placing in the Committee. All the claims placed before the Committee had already been scrutinized at various levels. Physical verification was initially done by the office of the GM, DIC, Senior Finance & Accounts Officer and Audit Cell of the office of the Commissioner, Industries & Commerce, Assam also verified the claims and admissibility of documents submitted by the claimants in the light of guidelines issued by the Government of India till date. The Committee was also informed that the claim put up through agenda note by the office of the Commissioner, Industries & Commerce, Assam were found to be eligible, admissible and in accordance with the revised guidelines.

The Member Secretary further informed that all the financing banks/institutions were also invited to the SLC to appraise the status of their financing units.


