Accordingly, the Member Secretary placed the claim before the SLC for discussion and deliberation. The self financed Unit was apprised by National Productivity Council Guwahati. The status of the unit was discussed in the meeting and the Committee was informed that the unit was running smoothly.

The Committee examined the claim on merit and after threadbare discussion accepted the recommendation amount of Commissioner of Industries & Commerce as eligible investment of Rs 6,19,95,931.00 which is lower than the recommended amount of appraisal report appraised by NPC i.e Rs. 6,44,63,195.00 due to deduction of some ineligible items identified during FVT & financial scrutiny by the Audit Team of office of the Commissioner of Industries & Commerce, Assam

The Eligible Investment of **Rs 6,19,95,931.00** and **Rs. 1,85,98,779.00 (Rupees One Crore Eighty Five Lakh Ninety Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Nine)** only as quantum of CCIS being 30% of the eligible investment is approved and recommended by SLC.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks from the chair.
