Member Secretary placed 83 Nos. of fresh claims and 9 Nos. of deferred claims, totaling 92 claims

The Member Secretary also informed that each claim has been verified by the officials of respective DICC office. On receipt of the claim from DICC office, the officials of CI&C office & Sr. FAO re-verified the claims and submitted report. Subsequently, the claims were processed and eligible amount was assessed as per the guidelines and checklists notified by the DPIIT, Govt. of India.

Agenda No. 2: Discussion and Scrutiny of fresh & deferred claims of Freight Subsidy under Freight Subsidy Scheme, 2013

Before going into the claim wise scrutiny, the Committee proposed to discuss the issue of condonation of delay in considering claims as well as various procedures taken for scrutiny of the proposals. The Committee took the following decisions:

- (a) Condonation of delay in holding of the SLC: The reasons of delay in holding the SLC, explained by the Member Secretary that the SLC meeting could not be held because most of the officers in field were engaged in NRC duty. It was further explained that the matter was also discussed in the meeting held on 20-06-2018 with Secretary, DPIIT, Govt. of India through Video Conference.
- (b) Issues of scrutiny of the claims: The Member Secretary placed 92 (ninety two) claims out of which 25 Nos. were NIL claim and admissible claims were scrutinized at various levels and re-verified by senior officials & Sr. FAO of CI&C. The initial physical verification had been carried out by the Office of the General Manager, DICC before forwarding the proposal to CI&C. Subsequently the proposals were examined by the officers of CI&C. The officers of the Commissioner of Industries & Commerce, Assam had examined the cases in accordance with guidelines, applicable checklists etc. of DPIIT. A senior officer re-verified the claims strictly as per Govt, of India & Govt, of Assam guidelines, where the claim amount is more than Rs. 5.00 lakh. Senior Finance & Accounts Officer of the Office of the Commissioner of Industries & Commerce, Assam had also verified each claim in the light of guidelines, Checklist etc. issued by DPIIT and Govt, of Assam and also checked the vouchers and payment etc.
 - 1.1 As per decision of the SLC dated 30-12-2015, annual capacity is considered and restricted to 100% capacity utilization annually. Accordingly FSS claims has been considered and restricted to 100% capacity utilization quarterly.
 - 1,2 Only Cheque payment has been considered and all cash payment has been deducted.
 - 1.3 Affidavit has been taken from the unit as per prescribed format with a declaration that "In cash of any information / particulars found to be false or to be misrepresentation of fact, I shall be liable to be punished under the law of land. In such case the entire amount of subsidy against that particular claim period so granted shall be refunded to the Government along interest"
 - 1.4 As per checklist of DPIIT "ANNEXURE-IV" the unit has also submitted affidavit as "That the unit has not claimed transport subsidy from any other source."
 - 1.5 All bills and vouchers, payment etc. has been verified by the Sr. FAO of CI&C.
 - 1.6 Calculation of FSS has been checked by Officers as well as Sr. FAO of CI&C office strictly as per guidelines and approved rates.

After threadbare discussion, it was found that the unit has claimed the cost of transportation through rail cum road which is permissible under the guidelines and such claim is lower than the actual cost of transportation paid by the unit.

Accordingly, Rs. 19,51,507.00 (Rupees Nineteen Lakh Fifty One Thousand Five Hundred Seven) only which is 90% of the lowest cost of transportation is recommendation by the SLC.

The unit is engaged in manufacturing of Atta, Maida, Bran, Suji in the district of Tinsukia and it has gone into commercial production w.e.f. 30.07,2012. There are 9 Nos. of FSS claim of the Unit and details of the claim are as follows:

The Unit has not claimed subsidy under Freight Subsidy Scheme, 2013 for the following four claim periods:

However, the following 5 Nos. of claim for the periods from 01.04.2013 to 30.06.2013 (4th claim), 01.07.2013 to 30.09.2013 (5th claim), 01.10.2013 to 31.12.2013 (6th claim), 01.04.2014 to 30.06.2014 (8th claim), 01.07.2014 to 30.09.2014 (9th claim) of the Unit are placed before the SLC meeting for discussion & consideration, which were deferred in the 3rd SLC meeting held on 09,08 2018.

The Committee felt that a detail verification / authentication regarding the source of procurement of raw materials, mode of transport, source of payment, capacity utilization and where the finished products are sold are to be carried out

and submitted to SLC.

The Member Secretary of the Committee informed that M/s Brahmaputra Cracker and Polymer Limited, Lepetkata, Dibrugarh has applied for registration under Freight Subsidy Scheme, 2013 in DICC, Dibrugarh on 03.01.2015 and accordingly, the FSS registration certificate bearing No. DICCD/15/FSS/NEW-5(A), dated 30.12.2015 was issued to M/s Brahmaputra Cracker and Polymer Limited vide letter No. DICCD (Ess)R-15-16/1149(A), dated 30.12.2015. The unit received the same on 07.09.2017 as per their letter. The unit had submitted their claim proposals in the Office of the General Manager, District Industries & Commerce Centre, Dibrugarh on 16.02.218 and the period of the claims are as follows:

- 1. 02.01.2016 to 31.03.2016 (Time Barred)
- 2. 01.04.2016 to 30.06.2016 (Time Barred)
- 3. 01.07.2016 to 30.09.2016 (Time Barred)
- 4. 01.10.2016 to 31.12.2016 (Time Barred)
- 5. 01.01.2017 to 31.03.2017 (Partialty Time Barred)
- 6. 01.04.2017 to 30.06.2017 (Partially Time Barred) was found time barred.

The claim proposals were checked as per checklist of DPIIT, Govt. of India and found shortfall of documents like bills, challan, consignment note, attested copies of RC, SSI / IEM registration. The General Manager, DICC, Dibrugarh was requested to submit the same & in response to our letter, the General Manager, DICC, Dibrugarh vide their letter No. DICCD (FSS)18/2017-18/800, dated 14.01.2019 has stated that the unit has requested for special dispensation for waiver from submission of shortfall documents. Moreover, the unit has informed that the SSI / IEM registration is not applicable as the proposal for setting up of Assam Gas Cracker Project was approved by the Cabinet Committee as Economic Affairs in its meeting held on 18.04.2006.

The Committee was of the opining that in view of the project being one of the projects under Assam Accord and a PSU, Govt, of India may be requested for waiver of the above as a special case.
