The Secretary, Govt of Assam, Industries, Commerce & PE Department, chaired the State Level Committee and welcomed all the members and officials present in the meeting.

The Commissioner of Industries & Commerce, Assam and Member Secretary of SLC for FSS, 2013 informed the house that Govt. Of India, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, DPIIT (NER Section) vide notification no. 8(28)/2018-NERS dated 04/09/2019, the last date was extended up to 31/12/2019 for submission of claims to DPIIT under NEIIPP, 2007/TSS, 1971/FSS, 2013. Accordingly, the State Government were requested that all claims for the period up to 31/03/2017 should be sent to DPIIT on or before 31/12/2019. But FSS claims of some units could not be placed before SLC due to change of checklist points a revised guideline of State Govt as well as shortfall documents for the particular period of the units.

It was also informed to the committee that Govt of India, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion vide notification no 8(28)/2018-NERS dated 8^{th} May,2023 has approved the last and final extension till 31^{st} July 2023 for submission/forwarding of the above mentioned pending claims to the DPIIT , and State Governments are directed to convene pending SLC meeting ,if any, in reference to all pending CCIS claims and TSS/FSS claims filed for the period up to 31-03-2017 . Accordingly, following FSS claims of different units for the period up to 31-03-2017 are scrutinized in terms of the above notification and communicated to the units to comply the requirements as per notified Check list.

Considering the above notification, Commissioner of Industries & Commerce, Assam had communicated to all the General Manager, DICCs vide letters no (1) CI&C (IV) FSS/47/2016/11 Dated 03-06-2023 (3) CI&C (IV) FSS/47/2016/19 Dated 11-07-2023 requesting all GMS to submit short fall documents and mandatory requirements as per check list applicable of each pending claims of FSS for the period up to 31-03-2017. Moreover a paper advertisement was also published in leading News Papers like "The Assam Tribune", "Assamiya Pratidin" Agradut on 11-07-2023 for the units who had applied 30% CCIS / FSS/ TSS in time and

requested to submit their claims with short fall documents at concerned GM DICC Office on or before 14-07-1/235550/202023 without fail. GM DICC Kamrup (R) had also shared notification in the Industrial Group of Kamrup(R) through WhatsApp. After receipt of claims from the GMs were examined and scrutinized at Commissionerate of Industries & Commerce and found following observations and accordingly unit wise and claim wise recommendations are placed before the SLC meeting for decision.

Agenda 1: Confirmation of the Minutes of the 20th SLC meeting held on 20.07.2023.

The minutes of the 20^{th} meeting held on 20.07.2023 was circulated to all members, and as no comments were received from any of the member, the SLC confirmed the Minutes of the $20t^h$ SLC held on 20.07.2023.

Agenda 2: Discussion and Scrutiny of Claims under Freight Subsidy Scheme (FSS), 2013 as per DPIIT's letter No. 8(28)/2018-NERS, Dated 08.05.2023

The Member Secretary, placed before the Committee a **total of 33 nos.** of claims pertaining to **11 no. Industrial Units.** Out of these claims 2 nos of claims were found eligible of M/s Sambhav Detergent (P) Ltd and accordingly claims were examined and scrutinized in terms of applicable checklist. Remaining 31 nos of claims recommended for rejection for non-submission of mandatory documents as per checklist, non-functioning status received from GMs and also the units declared to be closed as per report submitted by concerned GMs as per DPIIT's letter no. 8(28)/2018-NERS, dated 08.05.2023, claims filed up to period 31.03.2017.

The Member Secretary also informed that in pursuance of the DPIITs letter no 8(28)/2018-NERS dated 8th May, 2023 a temporary and special committee have been constituted for smooth disposal of pending proposals under FSS 2013 for the period up to 31st March 2017 vide no E 334770213 dated 24th July 2023.

Accordingly, the committee has thoroughly examined and scrutinized all the pending claims and the letters issued by the GM, DICCs time to time to the units. The payment details consisting of bill/ vouchers related to transporter were verified by the Audit Cell headed by the Financial Adviser (F.A) and recommended the eligible amounts.

The followings were the observations of the committee and based on the observation unit wise and claim wise recommendation were placed before the committee. Thereafter, the committee scrutinized the claims one by one.

(3) VAT payment Challan etc. (4) Sale/ Dispatched figure does not match with enquiry report and Annexure-II.

The Committee observed that ample opportunities were given to the units for submission of their shortfall documents within the stipulated time period but the above units had failed to submit the necessary mandatory documents as per comprehensive checklist of FSS, 2013.

The Committee also decided that no claims of the above units pertaining to their claim periods will be entertained in the future.
