Agenda1: Confirmation of the minutes of the last SLC : The Minutes of the 59<sup>th</sup> State Level Committee held on 15.05.2019 were circulated among the members .As there was no observation or comments from any members ,the Committee confirmed the Minutes.

Agenda 2: Discussion & approval of claim of 30% CCIS (Below Rs. 1.5 Crore )

The Member Secretary placed before the the Committee a total of 34 Nos of CCIS claims and 1 No of Court Cases.

The Member Secretary in formed the committee that :

All the claims were scrutinized as per policy guidelines issued by DIPP,Governemnt of India from time to time .He further informed about the procedures adopted for scrutinizing the claim before placing it to the Committee.All the claims placed before the Committee had already been scurtinized at various levels. Physical verification was initially done by the office of the GM,DICC .Senior Finance & Accounts Officer and Audit Cell of the office of the Commissioner of Industries & Commerce ,Assam also verified the claims and admissibility of the investment submitted by the claimants in the light of guidelines issued by Governemnt of India till date. The Committee was also informed that the claim put up through agenda note by the office of the Commissioner ,Industries & Commerce. Assam were found to be eligible in accordance with the revised guidelines.

The Member Secretary further informed that all the financing banks /institutions were also invited to the SLC to apprise the status of their financing units.

After threadbare discussion and obtaining the views of the officials of the Banks / Financial Instituions of the claim financed by them ,the Committee examinded all 34 Nos of **Central Capital Investment Subsidy claims** placed before the SLC and approved 18 Nos of claims and deferred 8 Nos and rejected 8 Nos cases.
