

Accordingly, the Member Secretary placed the claim before the SLC for discussion and deliberation. The project has been appraised by Allahabad Bank and sanctioned term loan amounting to Rs. 10.00 Crore (Ten Crore). Thereafter the loan has been taken over by Tourism Finance Corporation of India Ltd. New Delhi-17. The status of the unit was discussed in the meeting and the Committee is found that the unit is running smoothly.

The Committee members examined the claim and after threadbare discussion accepted the Eligible Investment to the tune of **Rs. 11,40,35,589.00** as recommended by the Field Visit Team constituted by Govt. of India and recommended **Rs. 3,42,10,676.00 (Rupees Three Crore Forty Two Lakh Ten Thousand Six Hundred Seventy Six)** only as quantum of 30% CCIS amount.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks from the chair.
